## Best practices for use of photo-zs in cosmology inference

## Dos...

- Treat photo-zs PDFs as the probabilistic objects they are
- Perform self-consistent analysis via Bayesian inference
- Use information theory to choose performance metrics
- Report all assumptions

## Don'ts...

- Reduce PDFs to point estimates
- "Stack" PDFs (or anything)
- Violate statistical independence or blinding
- Assign galaxies to bins by unobserved variables (or at all)
